

## CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDITS

The Healthy Kitchens, Healthy Lives conference is co-sponsored by Harvard Medical School and The Culinary Institute of America. The conference offers the following professional continuing education credits:

### Continuing Medical Education (Harvard Medical School)
